

Although we sanitize our facility with a veterinary-grade disinfectant (Roccal-D) before every session, puppy class comes with the risk that your puppy may be exposed to other dogs carrying diseases such as parvo and distemper. Keeping to the vaccination schedule recommended by your veterinarian is a vital preventative measure.

Puppies must not be taken to public parks, pet food stores (e.g. Petco or Petsmart,) dog shows or other places where they may be exposed to dogs of unknown vaccination histories during this six-week class.

If your puppy has experienced vomiting, diarrhea or fever, they must be clear of all symptoms for seven days prior to returning to class. Any puppy that has been treated for any contagious illness may not return to class unless they are cleared by their veterinarian.

Please print out the attached form and bring it to your veterinarian to complete. Your puppy must be up-to-date on their vaccinations and have received their most recent vaccination at least seven days before the first day of class.

For the protection of your puppy and others, this form must be handed in before the beginning of your first puppy class. **No puppies will be allowed in the building without this form!**
